Policy Document for Divyang Students w.e.f September 2022

Persons with disabilities are entitled to equal chances and rights in all aspects of life, including political, social, economic, and self-development activities. With this in mind, the Mangalam College of Engineering has taken a number of steps to make the campus more Divyang friendly. This involves Policy Document creation. The purpose of this policy is to prevent discrimination, exploitation, and exclusion of Divyangjan from all aspects of College life, as well as to ensure that Divyangjan with high support requirements due to disability, familial circumstances, or social isolation receive appropriate care. The detailed policy is as follows:

- The College office is responsible for maintaining student records.
- The College Principal shall give duties and obligations to teaching and non-teaching staff in order to assist divyang students with their issues.
- The College shall provide specific facilities for divyang students, as well as an environment that affords them access to excellent education and integrates them into mainstream society.
- The Office of Student Affairs shall be responsible to provide all the college services to the students with disability on preferential basis without any queue.
- The building lift shall be made available with assistant to such students.
- Signage including tactile path, lights, display boards and signposts should be accessible.
- Assistive technology and facilities for Divyangjan accessible website, screen-reading software, mechanized equipment should be provided.
- Provision for enquiry and information : Human assistance, reader, scribe, soft copies of reading material, screen reading should also be made available.
- A Wheel Chair and Walker shall be made available in the College campus for the needy students.
- The chairperson Exam Committee shall be responsible to provide scribe or extra time during the exam if required.
- The student's washrooms shall be provided with requisite facilities for the use of such students.
- The College shall provide career counselling session to guide and motivate divyang students
- A special parking area & ramp shall be provided for the physically handicapped students just near the main entrance. Students who are differently able are entitled to access to all schemes, facilities and services in the College without discrimination.
- The college shall provide barrier-free access, library resources, a scribe, and examination accommodations to all students with disabilities in accordance with the principles of equal opportunity, protection of rights, and full participation.
