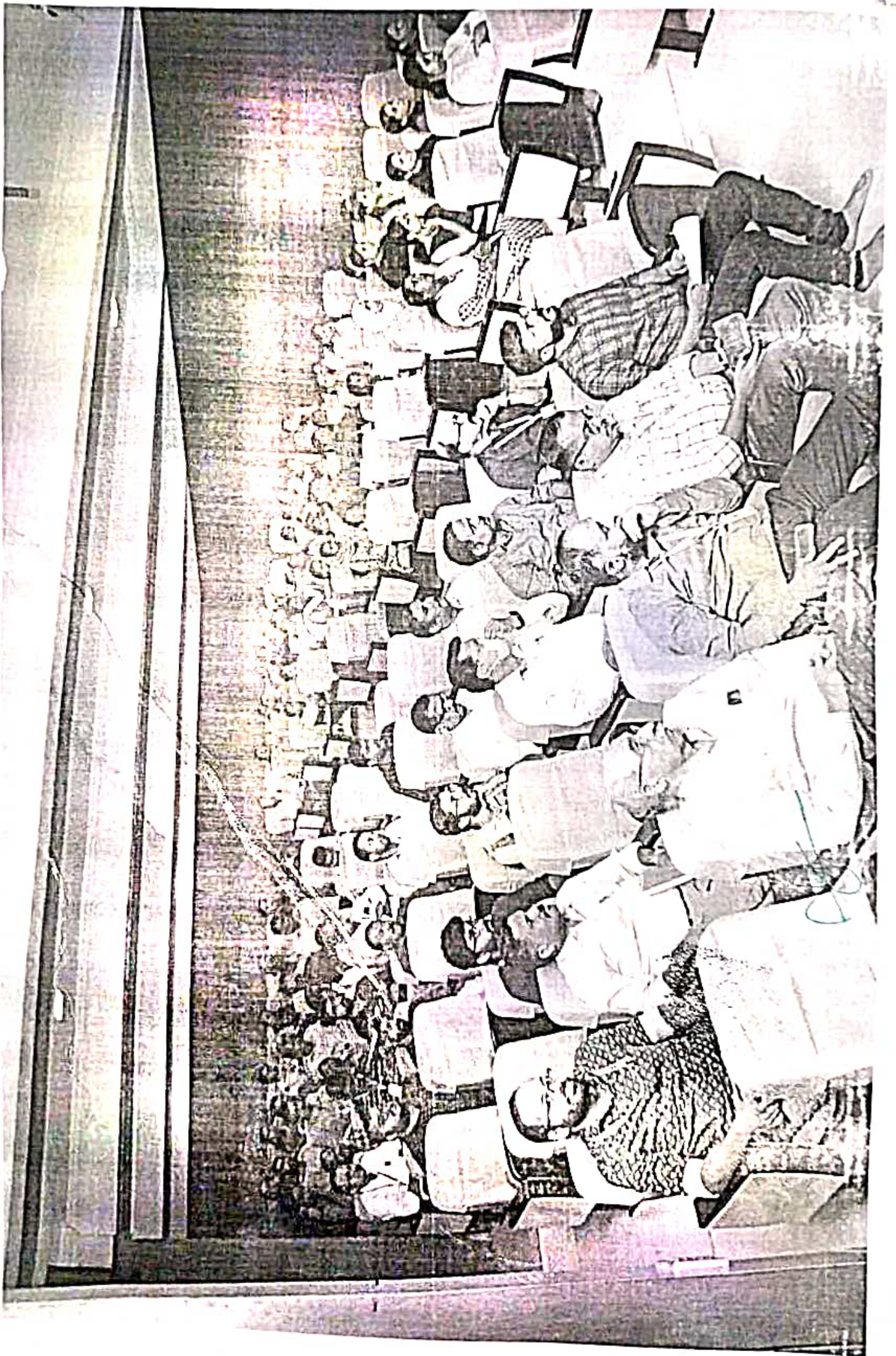

All the students and faculty members expressed gratitude to the CSE Department for organizing the session. Students are looking forward to many more seminars.

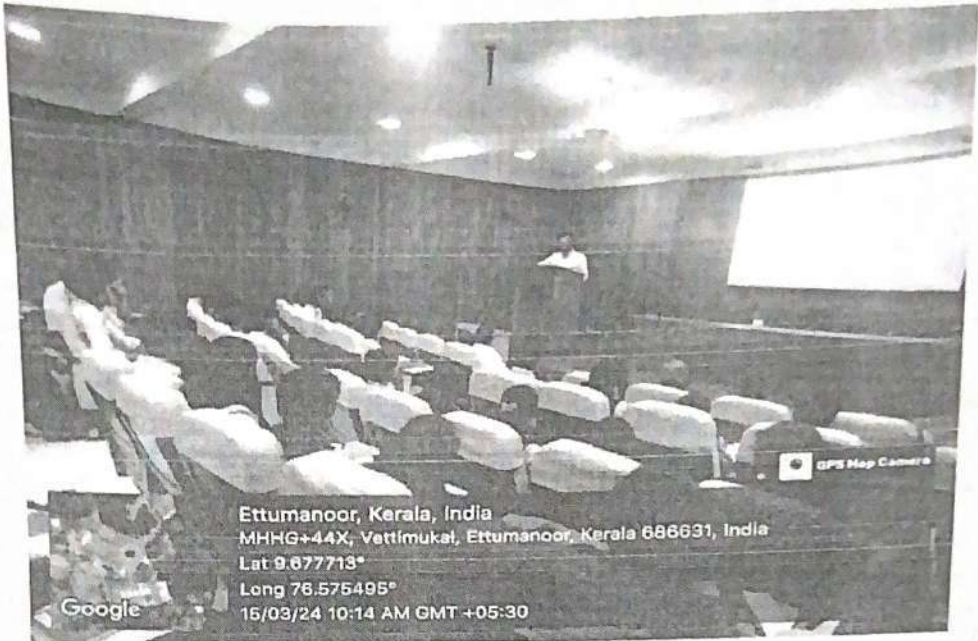

The event concluded with an interactive question-and-answer session, where students had the opportunity to engage with the speaker and seek clarification on specific topics. This



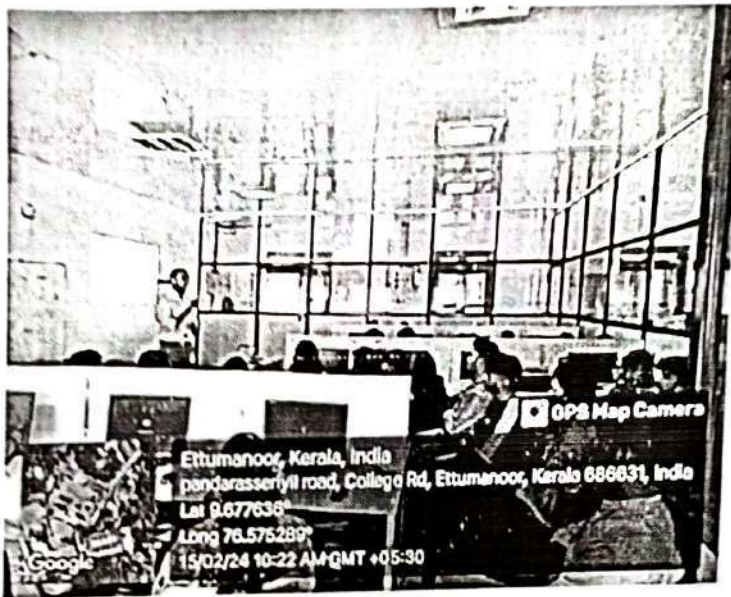


